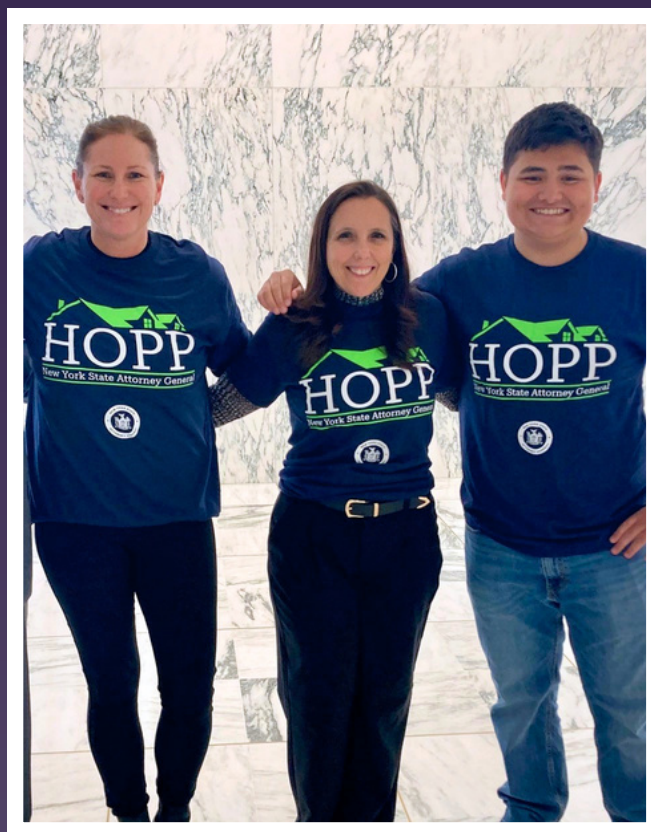

Bankruptcy and Credit

Advice and educational programs for those interested in starting or expanding a small business.

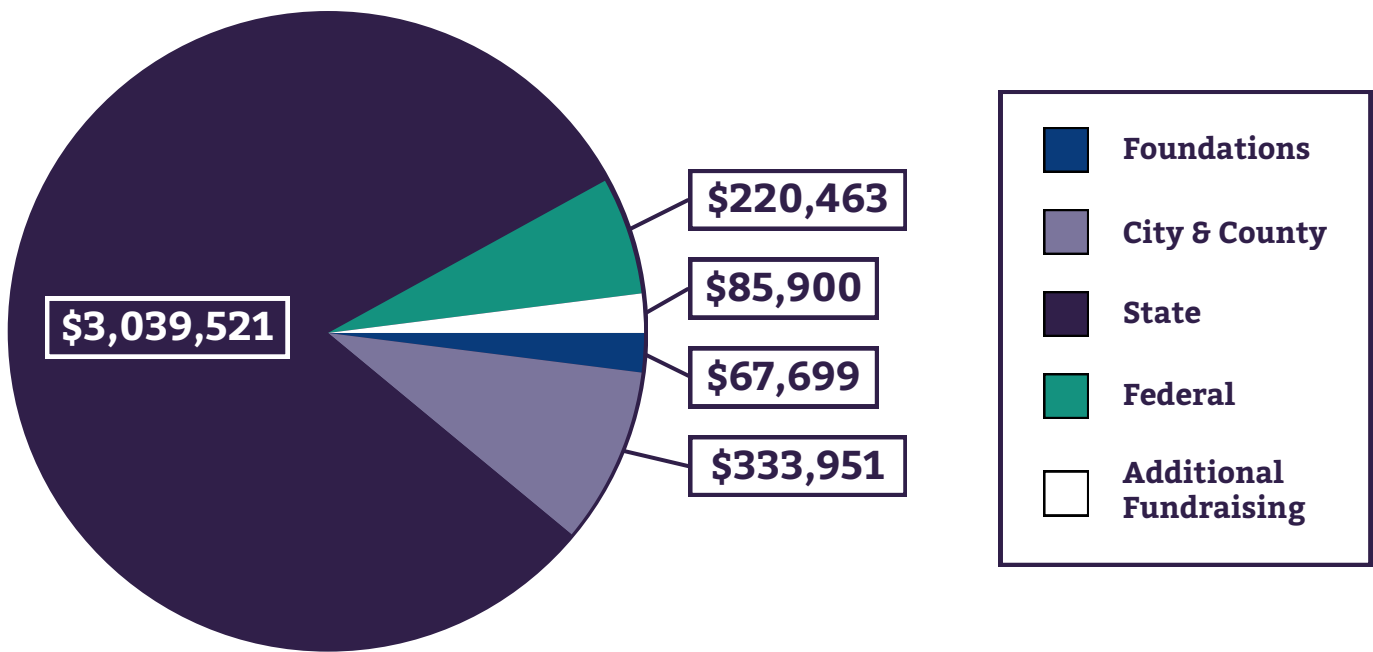
Uncontested Divorce

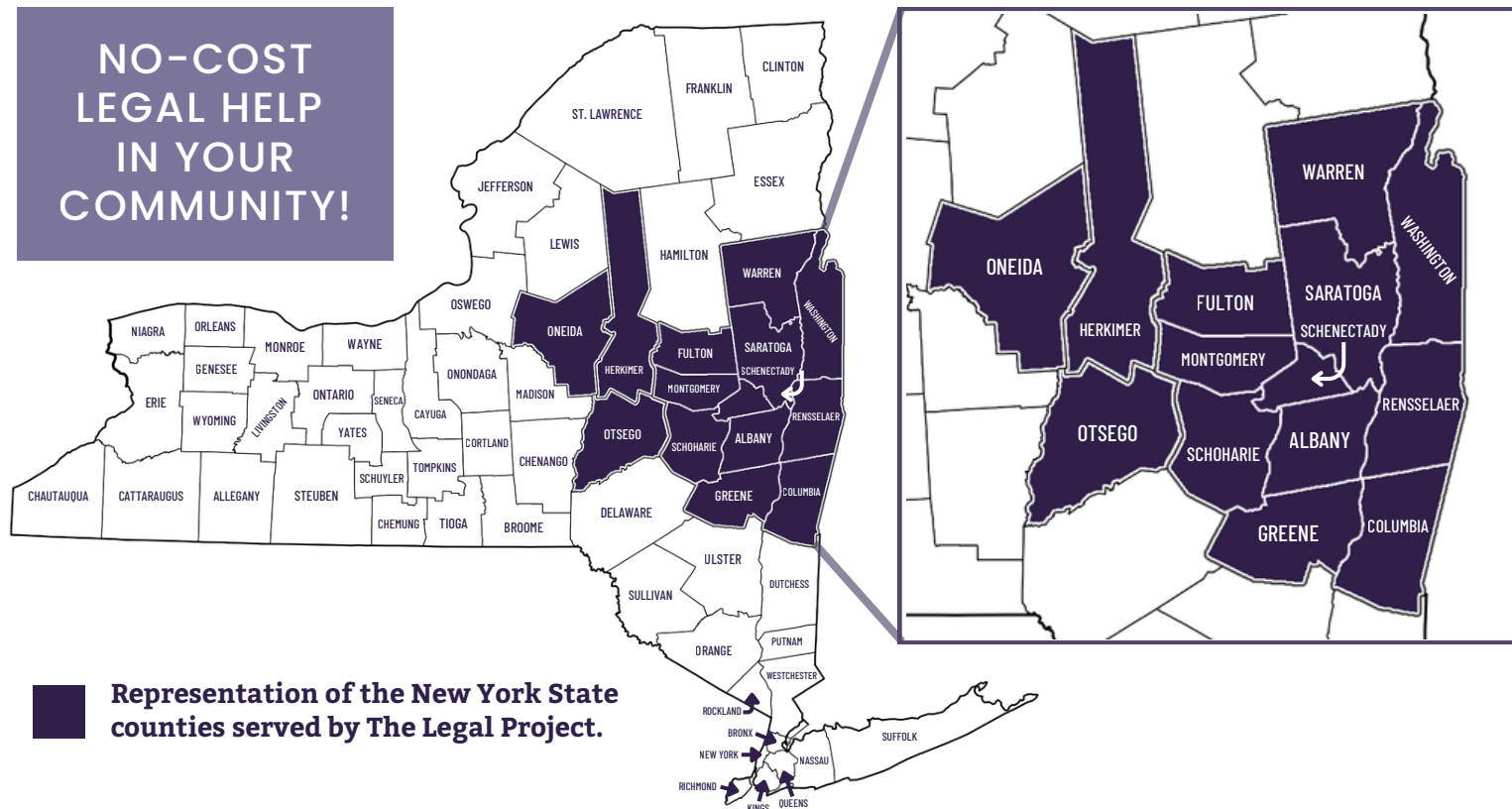
